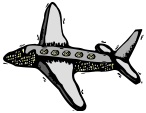

*Salt Lake City Boards & Commissions:* for information to be a volunteer on a board or commission, call (801) 535-6006

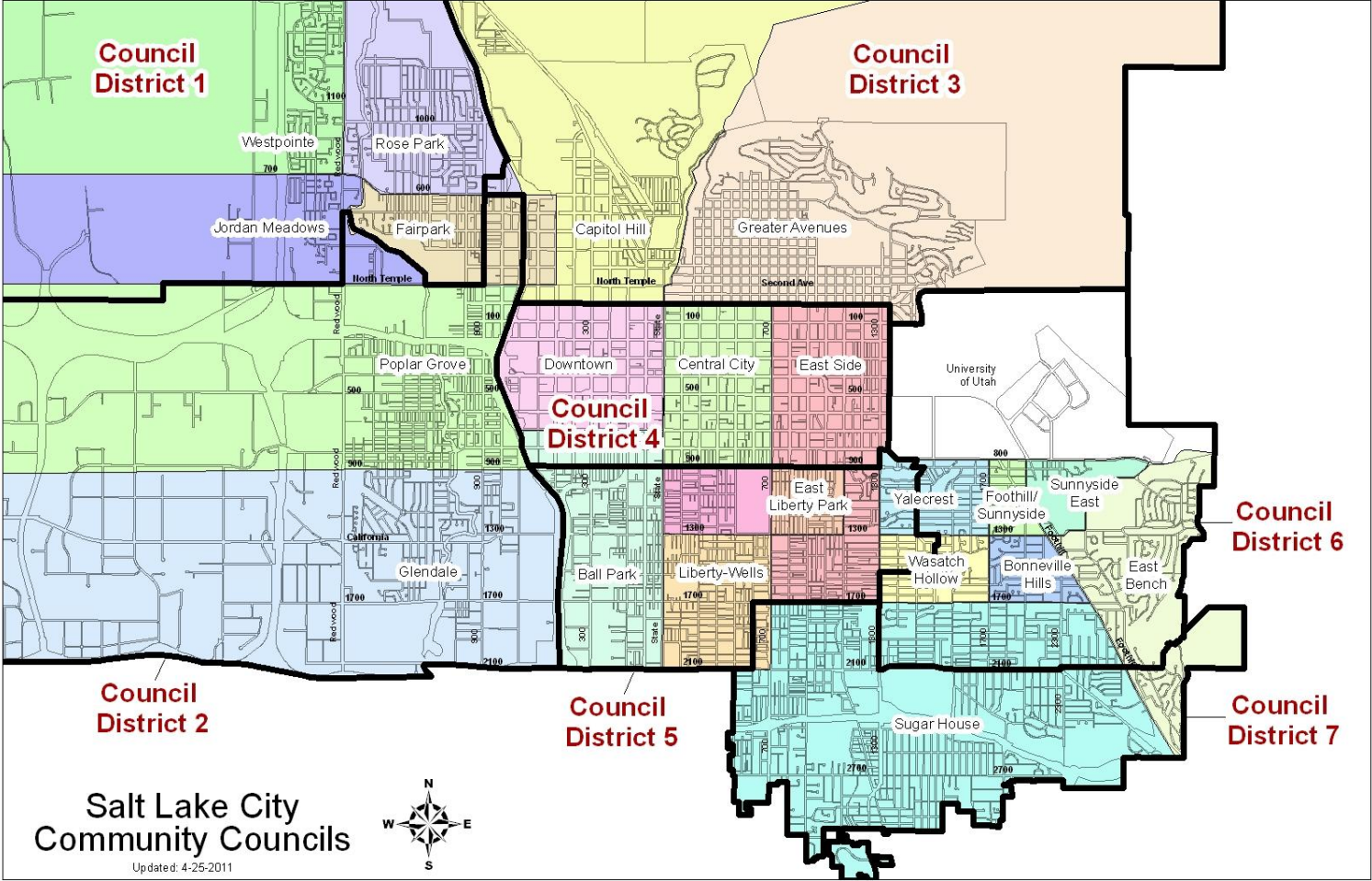
