Upcoming Dialogues Focus on Issues Facing Women in Contemporary Society

SALT LAKE CITY – The Salt Lake City Human Rights Commission and the Mayor’s Office of Diversity & Human Rights will host a Dialogue on Women’s Issues on Monday, November 21, 2011, from 3 – 5 p.m. in the Collegiate Room at the University of Utah’s Union Building, 200 S. Central Campus Drive. The event is one of a series of Dialogues on Women held this year to discover concerns women may have about health and safety, political and social environments, economics and education. The public is invited to participate.

The City’s Human Rights Commission has established a committee to analyze issues facing women in contemporary society. The committee will utilize feedback from the dialogues as part of a report which will inform future public policy. Co-sponsors of the upcoming dialogue are the University of Utah Women’s Resource Center and University Neighborhood Partners.

A Dialogue on Women’s Issues with Latina Women will be held on Monday, November 28, 2011, from 6-8 p.m. at Horizonte, 1234 South Main Street. The event will be conducted in English and Spanish.
